

AV Booster is fast, light, easy to use and agile against an emerging threat landscape. AV Booster's interface is deliberately simple, with a patent pending for exceptionally low memory usage, to maximize your performance without compromise. This means your business performance does not suffer from bloat, high memory usage or ineffective malware detection.

Getting Started

You can get the AV Booster set up quickly and easily on your PC by performing the following steps:

- Download the AV Booster from the following link location <http://www.pcbooster.com/products/avbooster>
- Once the download has completed, locate the installation file (avbooster.exe) and double click it.
- When you do so the setup program will run and you will be guided through the process of installing AV Booster onto your PC.
- When you run AV Booster for the first time, the update process will automatically run to insure that you have the latest version of the software and all components.
- Please note that you must have an internet connection in order to receive updates for your product.

How do activate AV Booster (Retail)?

If you haven't already done so, install AV Booster onto your PC by double clicking the setup file that you received in the download. Otherwise, if you purchased a retail copy, insert the CD into the CD-ROM drive.

- If auto run is enabled on your PC, then the installation process should automatically run. If you do not have auto run enabled, then you can navigate to the CD-ROM drive in a windows explorer window, locate the installation file, and then double-click this to run the setup program.
- In order to use to activate your copy of AV Booster, perform the following steps:
 - Run Disk Booster by double clicking the desktop shortcut (if created) or by navigating to All Programs > Disk Booster and then double clicking the application file. Locate the **Register now** on the main screen and then click the Enter Product Key menu item. Enter the serial number that you were given, and be sure to type the serial number correctly.
 - It is advisable that you copy and paste the serial number from the order receipt that was sent to you or the confirmation email that you received. It is important that the

serial number is typed exactly as you see it to properly activate your copy of Disk Booster.

- The program must have internet access so you may be prompted by your firewall to allow it. Internet access is required for finalizing product activation as well as receiving any product updates.

Interface Overview

Disk Booster can be run by performing these simple steps:

1. *Click Programs > Disk Booster.* Here you will find the main application file for Disk Booster. Double-click it and the program will open. You can also run Disk Booster by double-clicking the desktop shortcut icon that was created during the installation process if you elected to have one created.
2. Disk Booster will automatically check if any updates are available. If you have determined that your copy of Disk Booster is not up to date, or simply do not know whether or not your program is up to date, simply click Update to receive any updates that your program may need.
3. You will see the main interface when you run the program for the first time, which is where all of the major functions of Disk Booster will be accessible from. You'll want to get familiar with this screen because this is where you will be spending a lot of your time when you use Disk Booster.

How do I scan with AV Booster?

We recommend that when you first install AV Booster for the first time, that you run one full scan of your PC. While this may take some time, this thorough scan is recommended as it will help to index your PC. This will make future scans considerably faster.

To get started with the scan, click on **Scan** on the Overview tab.

Future scans with AV Booster are completely automated but you may wish to do a manual scan at any time by pressing the **Scan** tab.

You can choose a **Quick scan** that scans the most vulnerable areas of your PC. A **Full scan** will scan all areas of your PC but will take more time to complete. A **Custom scan** allows you to run selective scans in your PC. This option is only recommended for experienced users who wish to exclude certain files or folder or extensions. For example, you may wish to exclude your collection of music or video files from scanning, to speed up the scan.

How do I update AV Booster?

When you run AV Booster for the first time, the program will check our servers for any version updates and download the latest set of virus definitions. You can, however, force the program to check for updates, by starting the program and then clicking on **Update** on the **Overview** Tab.

From the **Overview** tab, you can monitor the health status of your PC and view the latest threat news. A Green cross means that your PC is in excellent condition. Red means that your PC is exposed to vulnerabilities that need your attention.

How do I whitelist and quarantine my files or folders?

Please press the **Scan** tab on the program, and then select either whitelist or quarantine options. From there you can either add files or folders to any whitelist that you wish to exclude from scanning. Alternatively you can quarantine any file or folder by selecting the Quarantine option.

All files that have been immunized by AV Booster can be managed from the Quarantine section. These files are not deleted from your computer, but are in quarantine and cannot harm your system. If you feel these files have inadvertently caught by AV Booster, you can unblock them from this console and they will be removed from quarantine. Please select the file and press **Restore**. Any selected file will then be returned to its original location in your hard-drive.

How do I use Game Mode with AV Booster?

Game Mode is a special mode designed to allow uninterrupted gameplay without annoying or real-time scanning pop-ups getting in the way. This feature will still quarantine suspect files but will not interrupt you during your gaming experience. To activate this mode, please click on the **Settings** tab, and select the **Other** tab. From here you can toggle **Game Mode** on or off. Please note that in Game Mode, suspect infections are quarantined as normal.

How do I schedule a scan with AV Booster and update the program?

AV Booster will periodically scan your PC against vulnerabilities. However, you can run a custom scan at any time. Please click on the **Settings** tab, and select **Scheduled Scanning**. From there you can select both time and day, as well as scan frequency.

You can also alter the frequency of **Live updates** from the **Settings** tab, or turn the option off altogether (not recommended).
